### Where to Eat & Party 2010 !

**Where to eat?** There are plenty of places to eat around town. Pick up a map from the Coonamble Visitors Centre. Al's Diner, Coonamble Bowling Club, Coonamble Fuel Centre & the Terminus Hotel on the North West side of town. Close to the centre of town there is the Coonamble RSL Club, Global Village Restaurant, Gumnut Café, Goose's Corner Café, Sons of the Soil Hotel, Kristi's Kitchen, Commercial Hotel & the Tong Fong Oriental Restaurant. Nearer to the Rodeo arena is the Coonamble Road House & the Cypress Motel Restaurant. There are of course several places to eat at the Rodeo grounds including the Rotary and Lions vans as well as the famous 'pre-school van' and the Coonamble Rugby Club van.

**What to See?** Be sure to visit the 'Nickname Hall of Fame' and see the pictures that adorn the main street precinct with stories about individual characters and their nicknames. Look out for John 'Vanderbilt' Lundholm a Life member and former President of the Coonamble Rodeo Association whose picture is near the Sons of the Soils Hotel. Don't miss the 'Patchwork and Quilting Exhibition' at the Coonamble Shire Library from 9am till 4pm on Saturday and Sunday. The Bush Poets breakfast will be held this year in the Historic Plaza Theatre in Castlereagh Street from 7.30am featuring Bourke Poet Andrew Hull. The Coonamble Greyhound Club has a seven race program on Saturday from 1230pm adjacent to the Rodeo Arena.

**Where to Party?** After the action finishes at the Rodeo arena there is plenty happening around Coonamble. Buses will be running from the Rodeo ground on both Saturday and Sunday evenings so don't drink and drive-Catch the bus ! Coonamble Bowling Club- Catch Alana Potter from Dubbo performing on Saturday & Sunday nights. Terminus Hotel-Live entertainment all weekend with Cowboy DJ on Friday & Saturday and Matt O'Leary on Sunday night. The Commercial Hotel will have a Mechanical Bull on both Saturday and Sunday. Sons of the Soil Hotel- Glen Clare will be playing 50's to the 80's Friday, Saturday and Sunday. Bucking Bull Hotel- Saturday - Mechanical Bull Show from 5pm Sunday - Hot Young Country Rock Guitarist Jared Scott with his Band Route 67. JD Promo Girls from 7pm Saturday and Sunday Nights. The RSL Club will have 'The Simmos' on Saturday night and 'Two Mates' on Sunday night.

**Entertainment on the Ground Saturday Night** There will be a community tug-of-war challenge on the Saturday evening from approx 6.30pm. Community groups will be competing against teams from the Rodeo and Campdraft.
