The 55th Coonamble Rodeo & Campdraft gets underway on the 12th June and the Western NSW town is preparing for the annual influx of visitors from across the State.

The event is run by the Coonamble Rodeo Association and an unpaid volunteer committee and consists of a two day rodeo and one day Junior Rodeo running concurrently with a three day campdraft. Special feature events this year include a poley saddle bronc ride and miniature bareback bronc rides. A feature on the Saturday evening will be a 'tug of war' between local community groups sponsored by the Coonamble Feedlot. One of the unique elements of the event is the fact that the association is a registered charity and each year makes donations back to worthy community organisations. The event attracts amazing support from the Coonamble community and this year over 50 businesses have sponsored including new naming rights sponsor Landmark. An innovation in 2010 has been the introduction of online ticketing with spectators able to purchase their tickets through the web site. Entertainment this year includes the Coonamble Shire Library's annual exhibition by the 'Material Girls'. From 10am-4pm Saturday & Sunday 12th & 13th come and view the wonderful works of many talented local ladies- over 50 full size quilts on display. Entry only \$3 with profits going towards landscaping projects at our new hospital. There will be a prize quilt offered for raffle with proceeds going to the hospital fund. Coonamble Bush Poets Breakfast presented by Coonamble streets ahead, come and see our renowned guest poet "The Bard from Bourke-Andrew Hull" and the Old Plaza Theatre, Castlereagh street, Coonamble.
