Two delegations from Sydney are also making their way to the Central West with Campbelltown City Council a major sponsor of the event and the University of New South Wales assisting the association with plans for the new Indoor Arena. Campdrafting entries closed within days of opening in early May and there are well in excess of 1100 runs over the three days.

A scale model of the planned Indoor Arena will be on display at the Rodeo over the weekend.

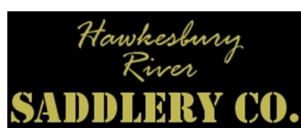
The miniature bucking broncs will return this year after being so well received in 2010.
